NJ FamilyCare Income Guidelines Just Went Up!

On July 8, 2008, Governor Corzine approved the expansion of NJ FamilyCare parent eligibility to 200% of the federal poverty level. This means thousands of additional New Jersey parents are now eligible to receive health care coverage through NJ FamilyCare.
