Eligibility

- Boys age 14-17
- Substance use disorder is the primary diagnosis
- Georgia resident
- Youth voluntarily seeking help
- Nonviolent
- All boys will be screened and assessed by professional staff prior to being admitted



Program

- 20 beds
- Trained, professional staff
- Average stay 3 to 5 months
- State sponsored program (no fees for admission)



 Boys may be referred by: counselors/therapists; doctors; parents, family members, churches, ministers, friends; court staff; DFCS case managers

A Safe Place for Healing

- 24 hour supervision
- High-resolution cameras and other electronic security equipment
- Weekday accredited classroom study from 9:00am to 2:30pm
- Individual counseling
- Supervised recreation on and off site
- Evidence-based Life Skills Groups
- Secluded, peaceful campus
