

Zika prevention — mosquito repellent* is now available as a Medicaid benefit!

Amerigroup Community Care will cover the mosquito repellents listed below for the prevention of the Zika virus. The Zika virus is a disease spread to people mostly by mosquitoes. It may cause illness and birth defects. Using repellents can help keep you from getting the Zika virus. If you get full Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids® benefits, you can get one can/bottle per prescription filled. Two prescription fills are allowed per calendar month. You will be responsible for any related copays.

How do I get repellent?

- Contact your doctor.
- Ask for a prescription for mosquito repellent.
- Ask your doctor to send the prescription to your pharmacy. Your doctor can send it to your pharmacy by phone, fax or e-prescription.
- Pick up the prescription from your pharmacy.

You don't need to visit your doctor for a mosquito repellent prescription unless he/she requires it.
