

Changes to Behavioral Health Services on October 1, 2018

KEEP THIS NOTICE WITH YOUR MEMBER HANDBOOK

Starting October 1, 2018, Amerigroup Community Care will offer more behavioral health services to NJ FamilyCare members. These changes are in addition to what is in your member handbook.

Amerigroup will cover behavioral health and detoxification services in acute care inpatient settings for all NJ FamilyCare members. This includes being admitted to acute and stand-alone psychiatric hospitals.

Amerigroup will also cover the substance use disorder (SUD) services listed below for members in the Managed Long Term Services and Supports (MLTSS) program, FIDE-SNP and clients of the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD):

- Outpatient care
- Partial care
- Partial hospitalization
- Adult mental health rehabilitation
- Opioid treatment services
- SUD treatment (outpatient, intensive outpatient, partial care, ambulatory withdrawal management and short-term residential)
